Mr. Sherman, the Executive Director and Chief Operating Officer of the UofL Foundation gave a brief overview of what the Foundation does and how it had grown since his arrival in late 2016. The Foundation is a non-profit entity, separate from the university and was created to receive, invest and steward donor gifts made to support the academic mission of the university. There are two types of gifts made to the Foundation – expendable gifts and endowments. Expendable gifts are not invested and can be used until the funds are gone.
