Gary Becker led us in conversations about new rules and regulations surrounding micromobility. These regulations emphasize registration, operation, bike and scooter parking. We were provided with a document in which the committee reviewed. Outlined below is what questioned about the document.

1. Language in the document.
 - a. Some of the document read as follows: Mobility riders “should have a valid drivers license to operate a moped or scooter.
 - b. Must have a valid driver license to operate a motorcycle.

The question was is if should or must. Gary stated that the document would be cleaned up for final review.

In addition, part of the discussion was about scooters in the residence halls. A representative from housing stated that there were no scooters allowed in the residence halls.

Discussions about fines and partnerships agreements were discussed. Will the company provide a fee or funding which will help enforce the rules. Parking would like to hire more student workers to help. Gary will research parking fines of other institutions and present in the final review document.

Dr. Taylor emphasized that 2 or more offences would then result in student conduct violations.

Lastly, Mr. Becker stated that maybe down the road, there would be an outdoor charging station.
