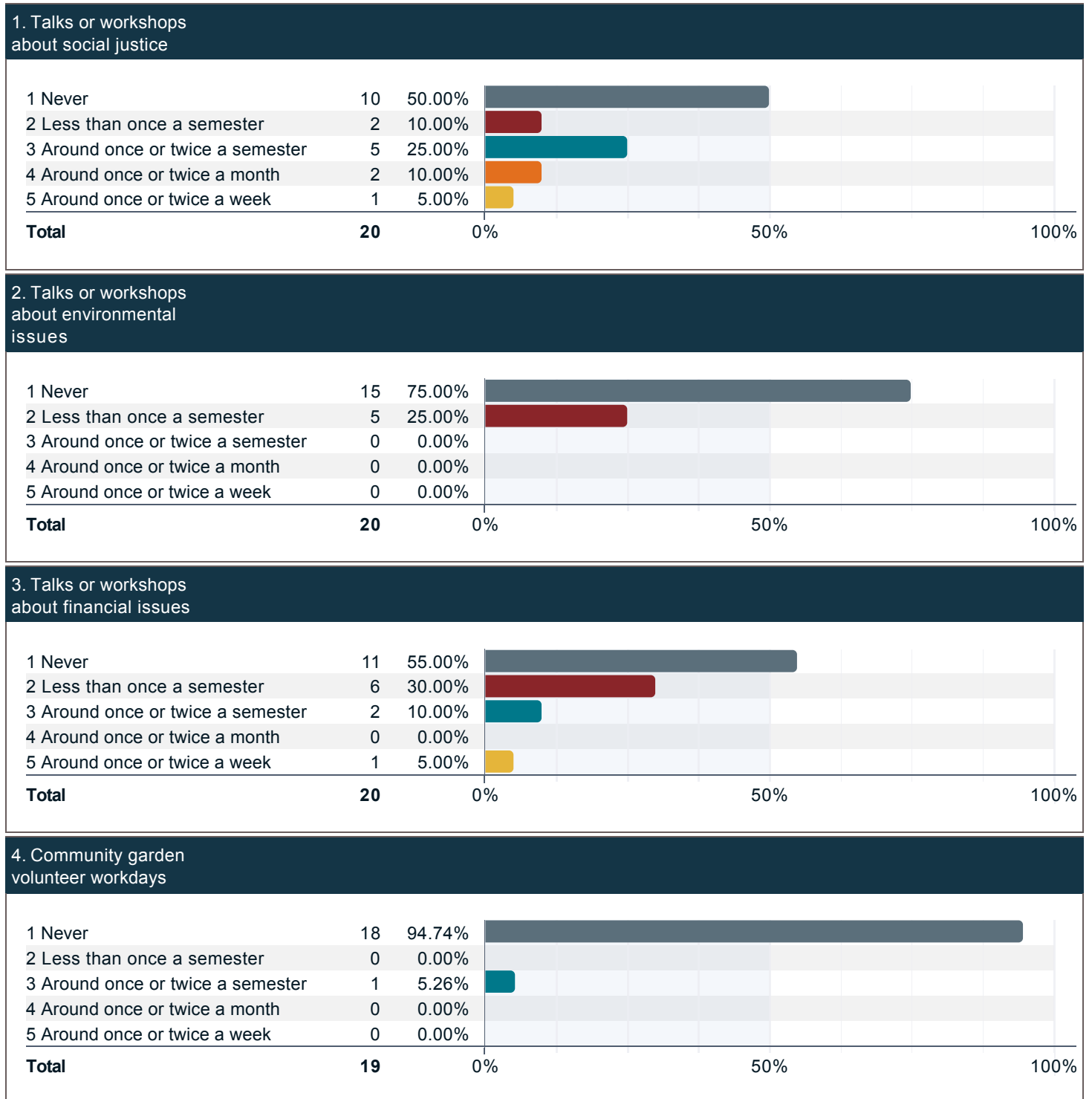

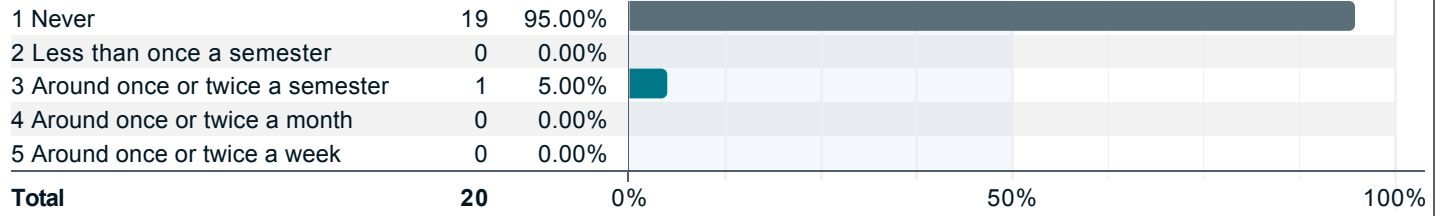

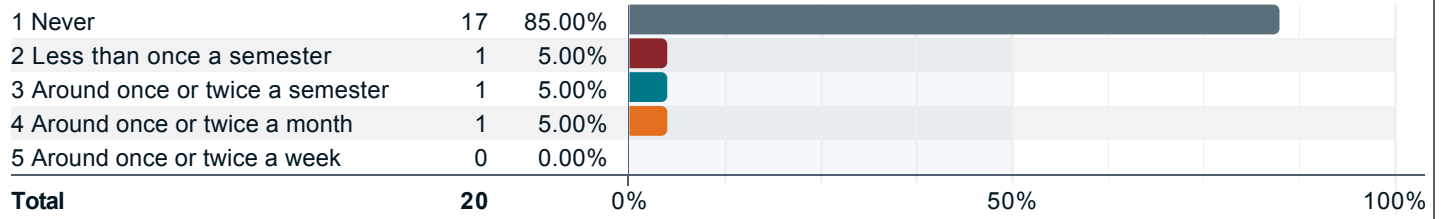
On average, how often do you participate in each of the following activities at the University of Louisville?

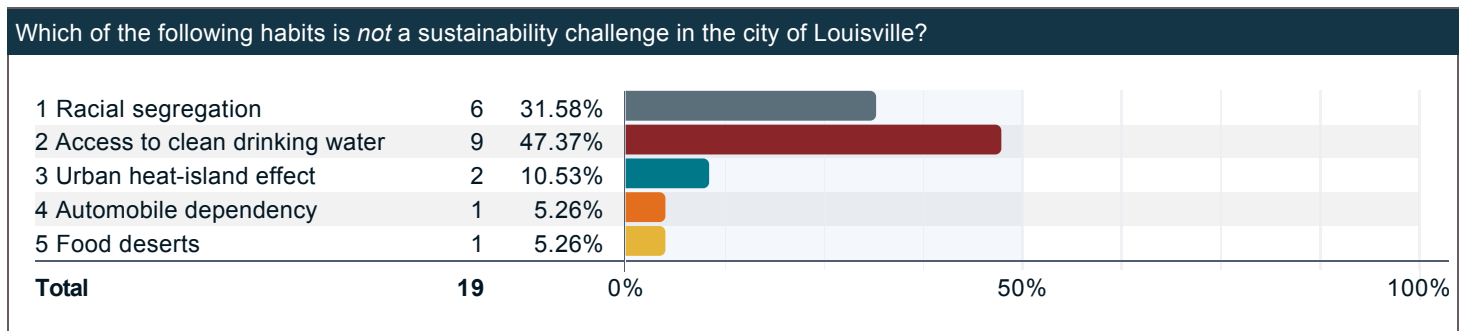
Which of the following is currently the larger source of UofL's greenhouse gas emissions?



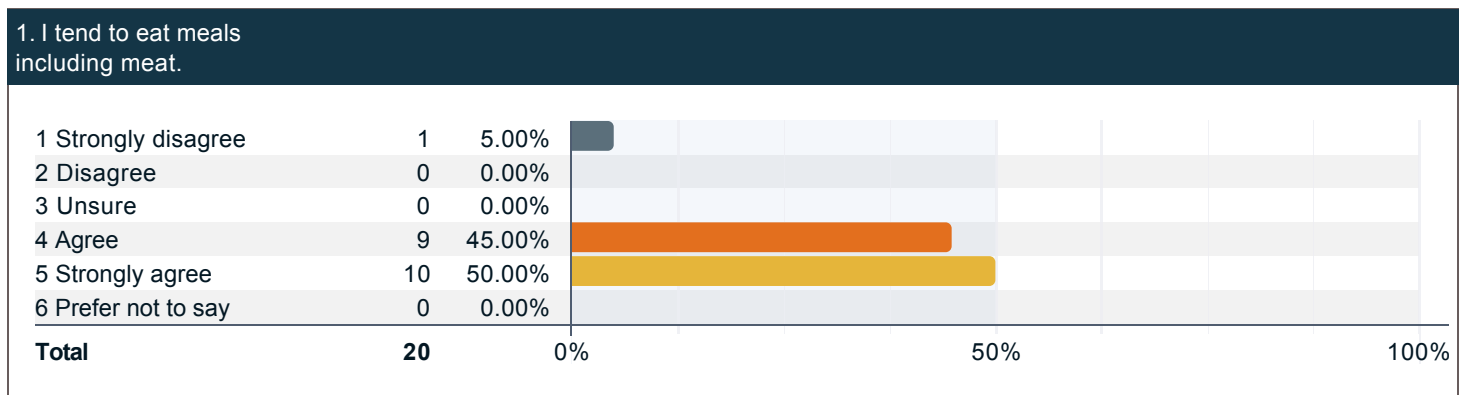
